This wine brings you straight in La Chapelle de Montlobre. With more than 300 years of history, La Chapelle hosts Montlobre barrels filled with Merlot. This cuvée is a house wine gathering families together around the fireplace. It makes every occasion special.

A fleshy and structured Merlot, offering an aromatic palette of red fruits supported by sweet pepper. A powerful but refreshing wine, coming from the bright limestone parcels of the South of France.

A powerful wine yet refreshing, great paired with meat, creamy cheese and long summer afternoons.
